Just show up. Don't worry if you feel lost—our Celebrate Recovery signs and friendly greeters will help you find your way to our meeting. Don't forget to stop by the information table and pick up some helpful recovery resources, a Newcomer packet and the evening program.

Our Celebrate Recovery meeting begins every Monday evening at 7:00. We will gather first as a large group to worship God with great music, relevant teaching and inspirational testimonies.

At 8:00 you will be dismissed to join one of our small groups. If you are a first time visitor, we will invite you to attend Newcomer 101 where we will explain the Celebrate Recovery program and how to find the best small group for you.

At 9:00 we will gather at the Turtle Lake Café for a time of great fellowship, hot coffee, cool drinks and tasty treats. Don't be in a hurry... this is a great time to slow down, unwind, continue small group conversations and meet some new friends.

Open Share Small Groups

Open Share Small Groups are led by trained facilitators. Each Group offers a safe place for men and women to be honest about areas where they are hurting or experiencing defeat. Anonymity, confidentiality and sticking to the guidelines are requirements of every group.

Presently, we offer the following Open Share Small Groups on Monday evening:

- Newcomer 101
- Men's Group: Addictions
- Men's Group: Codependency/Others
- Women's Group

In the future, we plan to offer Men's and Women's Step Study Groups. These groups will meet outside of the usual meeting times. These higher accountability step-study groups will go deeper into our recovery principles and practices. Stay tuned!
