Code of Conduct

For your information, we expect each student to conform to these standards of conduct:

- No** possession or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco.
- No** students can drive other students without parental consent either verbal or written (adult leader confirmed).
- No** fighting, weapons, fireworks or explosives.
- No** offensive or immodest clothing (Can be seen up, down or through or if underwear overtly visible).
- No** boys in girls' sleeping quarters and no girls in boys' sleeping quarters.
- No** electronic devices except cell phone if parents require (not for causal use or text messaging)
- Participation** with the group is **expected**.
- Respect** property.
- Respect** one another, staff members, and adult leaders (verbally and physically).
- Respect** and comply with event schedules.

Students who fail to comply with these expectations may be sent home at their parents' expense.
