

Understanding the Seven Seals

Number	The 7 Seals
1	Revelation 6:1-2 First horsemen of the apocalypse: What do we know about the rider? (Example answer: The rider comes on a on a white horse, there is a bow in his hand and he is given a crown.) Bonus questions: What is different about the rider in Revelation 19:11-21?
2	Revelation 6:3-4 Second horsemen of the apocalypse: What do we know about the rider? (a second example answer: The rider comes on a fiery red horse, he has been given power to take peace from the earth and make people kill each other. He was given a sword authority to remove peace.) Bonus Question: What does Matthew 24:1-35 add to your understanding?
3	Revelation 6:5-6 Third horseman the apocalypse: What do we know about the rider? Bonus Question: What does Zechariah 1:7-17 add to your understanding?
4	Revelation 6:7-8. Fourth horseman the apocalypse: What do we know about the rider? Bonus Question: What does Daniel 7:15-28 add to your understanding?
5	Revelation 6:9-11 Who is under the alter? Why were they killed? What question were they asking? Bonus Question: What were they given, and what answer did they receive?
6	Revelation 6:12-17 What happened? Bonus Question: How did the kings of the earth respond?
Interlude	Revelation 7:1-17 What were the four angels at the four corners of the earth restraining? There is a seal placed on the foreheads of the servants of God. Who was sealed? What does the seal mean? What does the one on the throne and the lamb do for his people? Bonus Question: The author takes 17 verses to communicate one major point. What is the main point of the pause?
7	Revelation 8:1-5 Why is there silence in heaven for 30 minutes? What happens to the prayers of God's people?
