## Questions from the Scripture

- What do these verses have to say about us as people?
- What do you sense the Holy Spirit calling you to do in response to what you have heard?
- Do you feel like the Holy Spirit is asking you to share what you learned with someone else? If so, who could you share it with?

## Questions from the Message

- What does it mean to deny yourself and take up your cross?
- When has it been inconvenient, uncomfortable, difficult and costly for you to follow Jesus?
- Our society places a pretty high priority on comfort. How do you move towards taking up your cross in a “comfort seeking” society?
