- What do you sense the Holy Spirit calling you to do in response to what you have heard?
- Do you feel like the Holy Spirit is asking you to share what you learned with someone else? If so, who could you share it with?

- What is your perception of God the Father? What sort of images come to your mind when you picture God?
- In the parable of the lost son, do you identify most with the youngest son or the oldest son?
- How does the parable of the lost son shape your view of the lost?
