- What kinds of people does Jesus say will be excluded from entering the new Jerusalem?
- What do you find comforting in these three chapters of Revelation? What disturbs you?
- What are three things you want to learn from this study in Revelation and apply to your life?
- Which one of the promises of God in Revelation 21-22 do you long for the most? Why?

Bonus questions for serious students

- Compare the first three chapters of Genesis and the last three chapters of Revelation?
- What words of Christ’s are repeated three times in Revelation 22:7,12,20? What is the significance of repeating them three times?
- What is the difference between the first and second resurrection? Why do you not want to be part of the second resurrection?
- If the book of Revelation was intended to give hope, challenge obedience, encourage faithfulness, identify deception, and live with unwavering holiness in this present world. why do so many believers limit the book to speculation about the future?
